

Taungurung *Cultural Experiences*

Accessibility Guidelines wawa dharrang experience

Getting there: The Yea Wetlands Discovery Centre is located at 2 Hood Street, Yea

Accessible Parking: is available in a flat parking lot located at the entrance of the centre – direct parking is **10 metres** from the entrance located on Hood St, Yea.




Image Caption: Car Park

Entrance: Yea discovery Centre has easy access from the Car Park to the front door via a ramp front entrance door width is 800mm and the Front Counter height is 1130mm

Entrance to the back area from inside the Yea Discovery Centre: Accessible via Floorboards to the outside area with a slight rise at the bottom of the door leading to the outside, access from here to the outside area is via a ramp leading to a pathway




Image: Back Entrance to Outside BBQ Area, back walkway to access the wetlands

Toilets inside the Yea Wetlands Discovery Centre: Clear walkway to the back of the Centre where the Toilets are located



Accessible Toilet

The width of the entrance is 1000mm and requires a turn to the right to access the toilet, the toilet door swings inward with the door width of 830mm with the floor to handle 1001mm. The inside toilet area is 2065mm long x 2040mm wide. The toilet seat height is 420mm and there is a handrail. The basin is 790mm high and has a pull-down handle.



Taungurung Cultural Experiences

Mobility – Walking Paths

Distance to walk to the lunch site – approximately 10 mins (700m) via 6 short steps

Expect a short, non-strenuous 10-minute stroll across uneven dirt ground that is unpaved, across the bridge and to the right down 6 short steps. The path then loops around across a mix of wood and gravel to reach the lunch site.


700m via the Franklin Walking Trail

Expect a short, non-strenuous 10-minute stroll across uneven dirt ground that is unpaved, across the bridge and to the left along the Franklin walking track. The path then loops through the wetlands across a mix of wood and gravel to reach the lunch site. No steps are involved in this route.

This area is outdoors so sun, wind or rain protection is recommended. All the terrain is flat but there are some small obstacles such as sticks, small rocks, puddles or compressed clay soils. There is seating available at the picnic shelter.




Image: the lunch spot – contains a long wooden picnic table under cover. Wheelchairs could park next to the table

wawa biik bus

The wawa biik bus is a Toyota Coaster fitted with a hydraulic wheelchair lift – accessible for one person in a wheelchair.


The wheelchair would be positioned at the back of the bus with their wheelchair secured to the floor.

Toilets - public

There are public toilets located at the Yarck Reserve, parking is available right outside the front of the toilets with access through a gate which measures (91.5cm) across, the toilets are enclosed within the Reserve and the only other access is through the front of the Reserve.

Women's


The width of the entrance is 1222mm and requires a turn to the left then left again to access the toilets, there are two cubicles. The door swings inward with the door width of 960mm and the door does not have a handle, the hand basin is 900mm high and has a push down tap.

Mens

The width of the entrance is 1222mm and requires a turn to the left then left again to access the toilets, there is a urinal and a toilet cubicle. The door swings inward with the door width of 960mm and the door does not have a handle, the hand basin is 900mm high and has a push down tap.

Paths / Access

From the roadway to an easy flat concrete access pathway the toilets are located within a fenced area of the Reserve with gate access only or access from the front of the Reserve 50m walk to the toilets


